

EDU 5601 Teaching Unification Worldview Intensive [Draft]

Course Description

- This is an online course meeting through zoom.

This is a 1 week 1-credit practicum on teaching the Unification Worldview in a one-day format. The course introduces the fundamental teachings of the Unification Worldview with a special focus on teaching the key lectures on Marxism and one supplementary lecture on the emerging Secular Worldview. Students who complete this will be certified as Unification Worldview One-Day lecturers.

The bullet points are more about action steps.

- Students will be expected to read from the text, the *Causa Lecture Manual*, in order to gain a basic working knowledge of the content that they are expected to teach.
- Model lectures will be posted for viewing prior to class because this is a flipped class. The later part of the course will be Zoom-based and involve two hours of contact each of the five days of the course.
- During the synchronous sessions, students will meet in pairs by Zoom. During these meetings each student will present and record one lecture. Students will evaluate each other's lectures. By the end of the course, each student will have presented and recorded five lectures.
- Students will receive power points slides and talking points for each of the lectures they will be giving.
- Each week students will meet with the Professor by Zoom during part of the two-hour synchronous session for Q & A, for guidance, and to allow the professor to comment on the student's lectures.

Expected Course Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, the student will be expected to:

- 1) Demonstrate an understanding of the core contents of the *Causa Lecture Manual*.
- 2) Demonstrate the ability to explain and converse about the primary concepts expressed in the lectures on the Development of Marxist Ideology: Overview and Critique, Dialectical and Historical Materialism, the Labor Theory of Value, the Theory of Surplus Value, and Lenin's View of Imperialism.
- 3) Demonstrate an ability to teach the content of a One-Day CAUSA Seminar.
- 4) Demonstrate an ability to present an overview of True Parents' lives and their role in addressing communism.

Books and Study Materials

- *CAUSA Lecture Manual*
- Power Point Slides and Talking Points for the lectures contained in the One-day CAUSA seminar.

Course Requirements

- 1) Students will present five 20-minute CAUSA lectures to the student they are paired with. They will evaluate each other's lecture. These lectures will be recorded and will also be evaluated by the Instructor. Scores will be based on the instructor's evaluation.
- 2) There will be a final exam on the *Causa Lecture Manual* designated lectures.
